Education Abroad & National Student Exchange Application Deadlines

Education Abroad is currently accepting applications for on-site winter break and spring 2022 education abroad programs through September 15. Students interested in a virtual international experience should apply by August 1 for fall 2021. Students interested in participating in a National Student Exchange program should apply by May 1 for fall 2021 or 2021-2022 academic year programs and October 15 for spring 2022 programs.

NMSU Passport Office is accepting appointments. Currently, passports are taking, on average, 10 -12 weeks to process and expedited applications take, on average, 4 – 6 weeks for an additional fee. Appointment slots are filling fast.

Did you know?

Passport vs. Visa

A Passport identifies a person's citizenship and is a minimum requirement to travel outside of one's home country. A visa allows a person to be in another country for a specific purpose, such as study or work, but can be required upon entry regardless of purpose. It depends on the individual country. The NMSU Passport Acceptance Facility can take visa photos for NMSU students studying abroad.
